The scholarship is available to students who are currently enrolled in a degree program at The University of Akron and who are planning to travel to Venice, Italy, to attend the Venice Biennale art exhibition.

The Venice Biennale is an international art exhibition that is held in Venice, Italy, every two years. The exhibition is one of the most important art events in the world and attracts thousands of visitors from around the globe. The Venice Biennale art exhibition is a unique opportunity for students to see and study some of the world's most famous art works. The scholarship is available to students who are currently enrolled in a degree program at The University of Akron and who are planning to travel to Venice, Italy, to attend the Venice Biennale art exhibition.

ELIGIBILITY:

To be eligible, students must:

- be currently enrolled in a degree program at The University of Akron with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.00;
- have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.50 and a minimum cumulative credit hours of 7100;
- be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident;
- be a member of the Phi Kappa Phi Honor Society.
