Students whose charges are paid in full and who have excess schotawshipsmay use those awards to purchase a meal plan or dining dollars in accordance with the following guidelines:

Commuter Students

Commuter students may purchase a meal plan that is equal to or less than the highest priced commuter meal plan for the semeste ORdining dollars up to that amount.

Example: Fall 2024, the Commuter 75s the largest meal plan and is \$,\$25per semester. Commuter students may use excess scholarship awterplarchase this meal plan threy may use excess scholarship awartespurchase meal plan and ining dollars up to the amount of \$525 for the semester.

Students may also ombine lower priced plans along with additional dining dollars, long as the maximum of \$,525 is not exceeded for the semester.

Residential Student living in residence halls)

Residential students may purchase a meal plan that is equal to or less than the highest priced residential meal plan for that academic y@Rdining dollars up to that amount.

Example: Fall 2021, the Gold Plan's the largestesidentialmeal plan and i \$2,845per semester. Residential students may use excess scholarship awardspurchase meal plan and ining dollars up to the amount of 2\$845for the semester.

Students mayalsocombine lowerpriced plans along with additional dining dollare, long as the maximum of \$2.845 is not exceeded for the semester.
